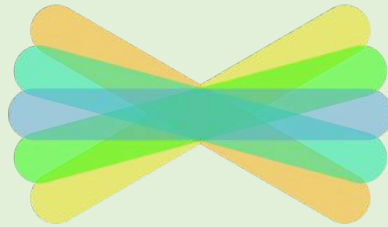

- ✓ The program seeks to encourage gentle, but firm, discipline without arguing and yelling.
- ✓ Not disrupting the class
- ✓ At the beginning of the term we discussed appropriate ways to behave in the classroom and what actions will end in consequences.
- ✓ When a student acts inappropriately, I will say that's a 1, 2 or 3
- ✓ At 3 that is a time out
- ✓ After this time they are invited back to join the class again
- ✓ If behaviour persists the student is then sent to either the Principal or Assistant Principal's Office and the parents are notified.
- ✓ Incorporated a positive rewards system (Dojos)



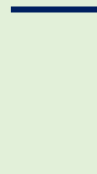

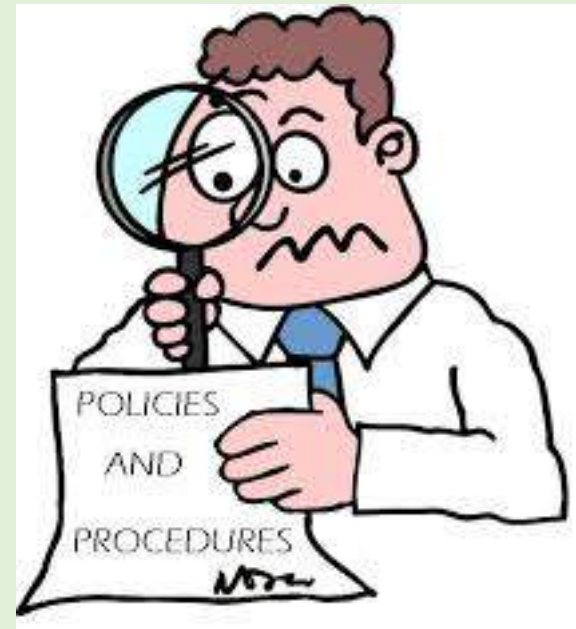

The 12 Conduct Statements

1. You act safely and competently.
2. You give priority to students' safety and well-being in all your behaviour and decision making.
3. You act in accordance with the values of the Gospel as defined in the Code of Ethical Conduct.
4. You conduct yourself in accordance with laws, agreements, policies and standards relevant to your relationship with the school community.
5. You respect the dignity, culture, values and beliefs of each member of the school community.
6. You treat personal information about members of the school community as private and confidential.
7. You give impartial, honest and accurate information about the education, safety and well-being of students.
8. You support all members of the school community in making informed decisions about students.
9. You promote and preserve the trust and privilege inherent in your relationship with all members of the school community.
10. You maintain and build on the community's trust and confidence in Catholic schools and the Church.
11. You act reflectively and ethically.
12. You allow students to have a voice in their education, safety and well-being.

Relating to the Code of Conduct

examples include...

- **Be involved in the life of the school.** Attend and participate in school events such as Masses, assemblies and sports carnivals. Volunteer for P & F and classroom rosters. Give witness that you value education by being involved in the life of the school.
- **It is easy for an opinion to be mistaken for fact.** Approach the relevant personnel within the school to verify the factual basis of a story can assist in allaying your fears as to the events in question.
- **Parents/Friends are expected to interact appropriately with staff, students and other parents at all times.** Raising your voice, posting online comments or forwarding emails to others, insulting behaviour to anyone on school grounds - is not appropriate.
- **Parents are expected to maintain privacy and confidentiality.** You treat personal information about members of the school community as private and confidential.
- Follow any reasonable instructions given by a staff member when on site and observe the signed parking areas of the school.

Classroom Times

St. Pius X hours are from 8:30am to 3:25pm, where staff are on duty. Any children at the school outside of these hours are not directly supervised and should be sitting on the benches outside the classrooms waiting for instruction.

Children not picked up at 3.25pm will be sent to the office where they will be supervised further, and parents maybe called. If this is a regular occurrence, then BASC should be explored.

Once children have been collected – it is the parent’s responsibility to supervise their children, this includes after school activities, sports and other events.
