RELIGION

Students:

- Make the sign of the cross
- Retell stories about Jesus
- Recite simple prayers
- Understand that Baptism is when we become a part of God's family

HEALTH, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL WELLBEING

Students:

- Explain what they can do in an emergency
- Label body parts and identify what parts are private
- Recognise good and bad touching
- Identify the difference between bad secrets and surprises

HASS

Students:

- Identify parts and features of different maps (world, country, street etc.)
- Recognise Australia
- Explore the birthplaces of different students and their parents
- Identify reasons places are special and how they can be looked after

ENGLISH

Reading and Writing Narratives

Fairy Tales/Dreamtime Stories

Students:

- Recall letter names and sounds (whole alphabet & sh, th, ch)
- Read and write CVC words using learnt sounds
- Write words identifying the initial and key sounds
- Form some letters correctly
- Write a simple sentence (including a capital letter, finger spaces and full stop)
- Read and write sight words (a, I, is, his, as, has, of, if, was, the)
- Read a simple decodable text
- Takes turns and speak clearly in front of teachers and peers
- Retell the main parts of a story (beginning, middle & end)

MATHEMATICS

Students:

- Count to, identify and write numbers beyond 20
- Add, subtract and share
- Sort and classify familiar objects
- Create patterns using objects and numbers
- Tell time to o'clock
- Order and connect days of the week to familiar actions or events (e.g. Sport on Tuesday)

TECHNOLOGY

Students:

- Learn to code – BeeBots and using the app. Scratch Jnr.
- Create a diorama of a season

ART

Students:

- Make characters and settings using different art techniques and skills
- Create artwork using patterns
- Create art inspired by Aboriginal artwork
