

Year 5 Term Three Overview 2020

RELIGION

Unit One: Eucharist

- People discover goodness from within
- Jesus demonstrates values for living as Christians
- Holy Communion strengthens people to grow as a community
- God speaks to people in the Word
- The Ministers of the Word proclaim the Word of God
- The Word of God teaches people to share their goodness

Unit Two: Penance

- People use their conscience to make good choices
- Jesus teaches people to choose loving words and actions
- People sin when they choose not to follow what God wants
- The sacrament of Penance helps people to reflect on the choices they make and helps people to choose to live good lives

MATHEMATICS

Mental Math:

Students will explore division strategies through *Think Mentals* (whole school approach).

Fractions & Decimals

- Order decimals and unit fractions and locate them on number lines
- Add and subtract fractions with the same denominator

Statistics & Probability

- Interpreting different data sets
- Listing outcomes of chance experiments with equally likely probabilities and assign probabilities between 0 and 1
- Posing questions to gather data, and construct data displays appropriate for the data

HEALTH

In Health, students will identify practical strategies for promoting a healthy lifestyle, including preventative health such as sun safety.

ENGLISH

Spelling:

- Diana Rigg spelling program (whole school approach)

Speaking & Listening

- Listen and ask questions to clarify content
- Creating presentations which include multimodal elements for defined purposes
- Identify aspects of literary texts that convey details or information about particular social, cultural and historical contexts

Writing:

- Use language features to show how ideas can be extended
- Creating imaginative and informative texts for different purposes and audiences

Reading:

- Describing how events, characters and settings in texts are depicted and explaining their own responses to them

H.A.S.S.

History: Students will identify the cause and effect of change on Australia's colonies, and describe aspects of the past that have remained the same. They describe the different experiences of people in the past. Students recognise the significance of a group, individual, event or development in bringing about change in the Swan River Colony.

TECHNOLOGIES

Design and Technology

In materials and technologies specialisations, students outline and apply suitable and safe practices and are able to classify the characteristics and properties of a range of materials and components.

ART

Over the year, students will create artwork by selecting and using a range of techniques suitable to selected art forms. They will produce and enhance their finished artwork by manipulating complex shapes, using a variety of line types, creating and using a range of colours and different textures.
