Religion

Unit One: Baptism

- People learn that all people and creation are important
- Jesus teaches people to show love through actions
- Anointing with Chrism is an important element in the Rite of Baptism
- Baptised people live their lives justly and show everyone the same love and goodness

Unit Two: Advent Christmas

- People learn from and remember stories
- Christians listen to stories of God's promise to send a Saviour during Advent
- People learn many names for Jesus from the Bible
- Advent is a time for preparing for Christmas

Mathematics

Number & Algebra:

- Describe, continue and create patterns, fractions, decimals and whole numbers resulting from addition and subtraction
- Find unknown quantities and identify equivalent number sentences involving multiplication and division

Measurement

- Compare 12- and 24-hour time systems and convert between them
- Estimate, measure and compare angles using degrees
- Construct angles using a protractor
- Connect three-dimensional objects with their nets and other two-dimensional representations

Statistics & Probability

- Describe and interpret different data sets in context

Health

- Preventative health measures that promote and maintain an individual's health, safety and wellbeing.

- Diana Rigg spelling program (whole school approach)

Writing:

- Continue to develop understandings of grammar and punctuation by using a variety of sentence types when writing
- Focus text types: Letter writing, Invitations and Speeches

Reading:

- Understand how to move beyond making bare assertions and take account of differing perspectives and points of view
- Identify aspects of literary texts that convey details or information about particular social, cultural and historical events

Speaking and Listening

- Make presentations which include multimodal elements for defined purposes.
